About the Conductor

Dr. Donald Lovejoy is the Director of Bands and Coordinator of Brass Studies at Winona State University. In addition to directing the Symphonic Wind Ensemble and the WSU Pep Band, he also teaches courses in instrumental music education, conducting, and music theory. Dr. Lovejoy's academic degrees include a B.A. in Music Education from Asbury College (KY), a masters degree in orchestral conducting from the University of Regina (Canada), a masters degree in trumpet performance from Northwestern University (IL) and a doctorate in conducting from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

From 1979 to 1986 Dr. Lovejoy was assistant principal trumpet with the Regina Symphony Orchestra (Canada) and also performed as a member of the touring orchestras for the Sadler Wells Ballet and the Royal Winnipeg Ballet. While in Canada he also played for the tours of such artists as Harry Belafonte, Della Reese, and Cleo Laine. Dr. Lovejoy has also performed with the South Bend Symphony, Northwest Indiana Symphony, and with various regional orchestras in the Chicago area and has maintained an active schedule as a freelance trumpet player and conductor. He is currently co-principal trumpet in the Winona Symphony and has also performed recently with the LaCrosse Symphony.

As a wind conductor, Dr. Lovejoy has been the Director of Bands at Bethel College (IN) and St. Xavier University (IL) as well as assistant conductor for the UW-Madison Wind Ensemble, Sinfonietta, and Concert Band. Since 1985, Dr. Lovejoy has been active as a clinician in Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, and Minnesota working with both bands and orchestras at the middle school, high school and college levels.

About the Conductor

Amy K. Roisum Foley is a Ph.D. candidate in music education and wind band conducting from the University of Minnesota. She received her B.A. in music education from St. Olaf College and her M.A. in curriculum and instruction from the University of St. Thomas. Prior to attending the university, she served as music educator and conductor, union officer, advisor, mentor, representative, chaperone, department head, and student advocate in the Lakeville Public Schools. Roisum Foley also spent two years as associate conductor for the Hopkins Westwind Concert Band.

Roisum Foley is currently the Director of Bands at Minnesota State University at Mankato where she administrates and conducts the Concert Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band, coordinates the Athletic Band and coaches several chamber ensembles. In addition, she also teaches the Instrumental Musicianship Course. Roisum Foley has served as guest conductor and clinician for several honor bands and festivals in Minnesota and Canada. Prior to coming to MSU she served as a sabbatical replacement for the Director of Bands at the University of Prince Edward Island, Canada and at Gustavus Adolphus College. Roisum Foley is looking forward to a long and rewarding career as a conductor and music educator.
