**About the Conductor**

Dr. Teachout teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in instrumental music education at the University of Minnesota and supervises student teachers. In addition, he is the National Chairperson for the Collegiate Music Educators National Conference. Prior to joining the faculty at the University of Minnesota, he taught undergraduate and graduate courses at the Pennsylvania State University; he also enjoyed ten years of successful public school instrumental music teaching experience in Oklahoma.

With degrees from West Virginia University, the University of Oklahoma, and Kent State University, Teachout has been an active teacher, clinician, and researcher. While he was an instrumental music teacher in Oklahoma, his groups earned four consecutive Oklahoma Secondary School Activity Association Outstanding Achievement Awards and his program was observed by the instrumental music education classes of Cameron University, Oklahoma State University, Oklahoma Baptist University, and the University of Oklahoma as a model for instrumental music instruction. He has also been invited to conduct ensembles and present clinics in Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Minnesota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, and West Virginia.

### About the Conductor

Dr. Robert Hallquist earned his B.A. in Music Education at Hamline University and a B.A. and Ph. D. at the University of Minnesota. He was named Jazz Educator of the Year in 1989 by the International Association of Jazz Educators and Band Music Educator of the Year in 1991 by the Minnesota Music Educators Association. Dr. Hallquist's teaching experience included two years as band and choir director at Arlington, MN, and thirty-five years as band director at Roseville, MN. He also served as interim band director for Augsburg and Gustavus Adolphus Colleges and was a brass instructor at Hamline University.

Throughout his teaching career Dr. Hallquist remained active as a professional trumpet player including numerous performances with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, Minneapolis Civic Orchestra, Center Opera Company, and extensive free-lance jobbing. In retirement from teaching he remains active as a conductor and performer. He is currently musical director for The Bend In The River Big Band, a Gustavus alumni jazz band, and will direct the Minnesota Ambassadors Concert Band on a sixteen day European tour this summer.
